

Rules for Writing a Bibliography – Annexe no. 1

- Use alphabetic order in the bibliography
- Provide bibliographic entries with their DOI number, if applicable (the DOI can be found on the website <http://www.crossref.org/guestquery/>)
- Bibliography editing rules according to the APA standard:
- a book: Author, A. (year). *Book title*. Publisher city: Publisher. doi: xyzxyz [Wilson, J., (1943). *Studies on Agriculture in Poland*. Poznań: University Publishing House. doi: xyzxyz]
- an article in a joint publication: Author, A. (year). Title. In: A. Author (ed.), *Book title* (pages). Publisher city: Publisher. doi: xyzxyz [Wilson, J. (1999). Potato Farming in the Polish People's Republic. In: A. Mańkowski (ed.), *Agriculture in Poland* (pp. 223–278). Poznań: Poznań Publishing House. doi: xyzxyz]
- an article in a journal: Author, A. (year). Article title. *Periodical title, volume*(issue), pages. doi: xyzxyz [Mankowski, K., 2010. History of Family. *Sociology*, 2(1), 110–120. doi: xyzxyz]
- an article found online (without doi): Author, A. (year). Title. *Name of the periodical or domain, volume*(issue), pages. Retrieved from <http://.....> [Arakji, R. Y., & Lang, K. R. (2008). Avatar business value analysis: A method for the evaluation of business value creation in virtual commerce. *Journal of Electronic Commerce Research*, 9, 207–218. Retrieved from <http://www.csulb.edu/journals/jecr/>]
- an article found online (with doi): Author, A. (year). Title. *Name of the periodical or domain, volume*(issue), pages. doi: xyzxyz [Wilens, T. E., & Biederman, J. (2006).
