## Second meeting of the Polish-Ukrainian Forum of Historians in Warsaw – 14–15 March 2016

On14-15 March 2016 second meeting of the Polish-Ukrainian Forum of Historians washeld. Proceedings in Warsaw were devoted to issues related to the activities ofPolish and Ukrainian underground in the territory of today's Western Ukraineduring the Second World War. The speakers were prof. Grzegorz Mazur and Prof.Ihor Ilyushin, and Prof. Ivan Patryliak and Prof. Grzegorz Motyka.

Representatives of the Ukrainian Institute of National Remembrance handed to Polish historianscopies of 10 volumes from the archives of the SBU, which relate to the Polish "SilentUnseen" of 1940s – Wacław Kopisto. These materials have recently been found byworkers of the Ukrainian Institute of National Remembrance. This took placeafter the Ukraine postponed the founding of the table to commemorate Kopisto.Guests from Ukraine declared that the transfer of documents is a gesture of openness,mutual respect and the scientific reliability of the Polish-Ukrainian dialogueon the past.

Thenext meeting of the Polish-Ukrainian Forum of Historians isscheduled for October 2016 in Ukraine.
