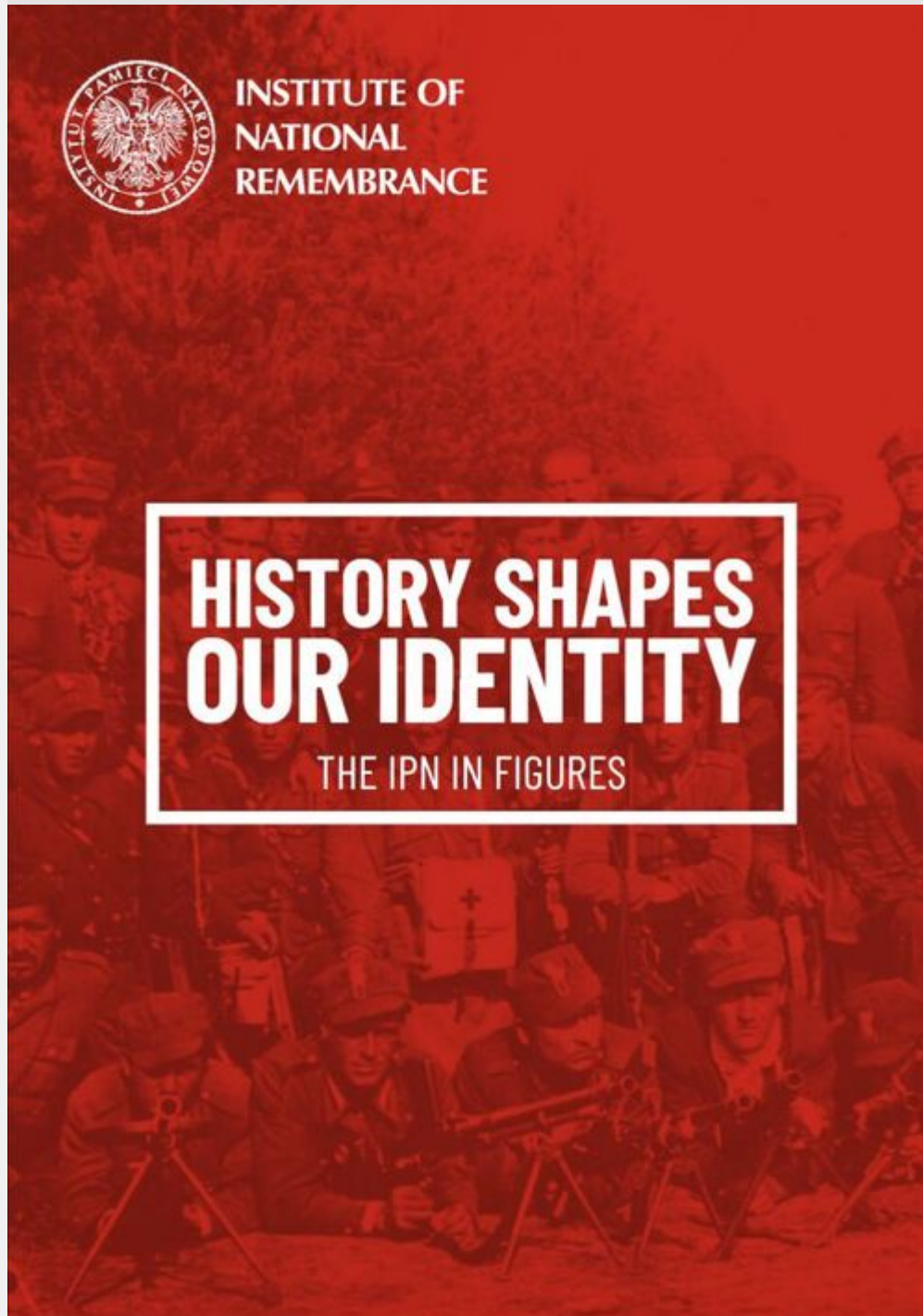

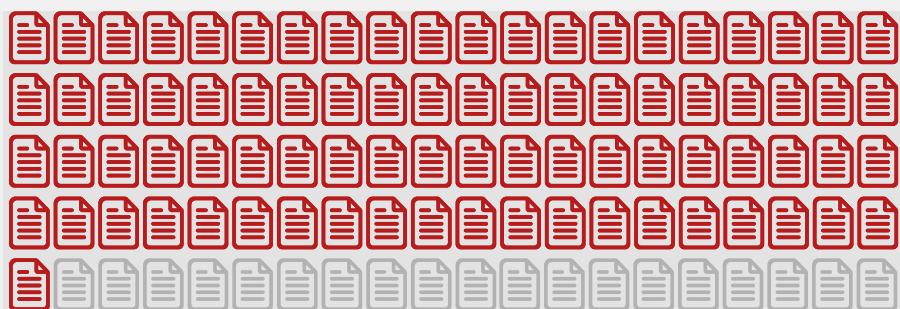

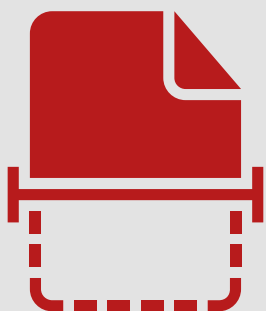

Archive

The IPN Archive collects, analyzes and makes available documents on the fate of the Polish Nation and Polish citizens of other nationalities in the years 1917-1990.



We have collected over **90 km** of files.



286,960 photographs have been scanned.



The archive information system makes available **17,048,272 records**



We have completed processing of **3,999,210 applications, queries and reports.**

Archive full of Remembrance

It aims at preserving our cultural heritage, including precious documents. It is also a platform for information exchange with potential donors, who would wish to share their family documents with the IPN.

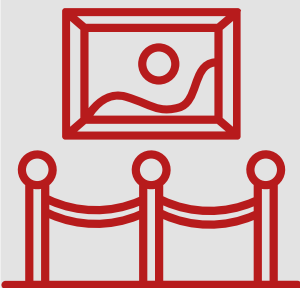

Education

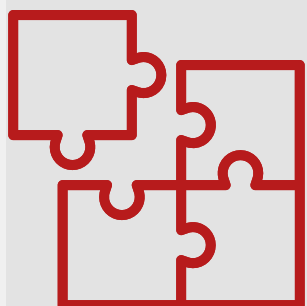

The project is realized at the regional level by the IPN's branches and delegations. Winners of regional competitions take part in the finals: the Historical Debate Competition.

History Point

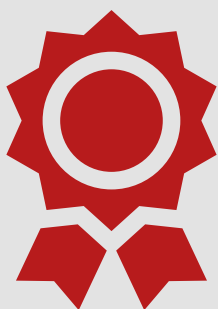

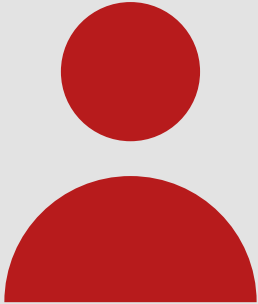

Office of Search and Identification conducts searches of unknown burial sites of those fallen in combat and victims of totalitarianisms from 8 November 1917 to 31 July 1990, and restores identity to those who were sentenced to oblivion under communist rule.
