Karol Tendera, a prisoner of German concentration camps and a Witness to History, passed away at the age of 98.



Karol Tendera, a former prisoner of the German camps of KL Auschwitz and KL Flossenbürg (Leitmeritz) passed away at the age of 98. Karol Tendera undertook various actions aimed at preserving the memory of the victims of crimes committed by the Germans during World War II. He cooperated with the Auschwitz-Birkenau Victims Memorial Foundation in Oświęcim, participated in many educational meetings, and continuously shared his experience of war, viewing it as a warning of the effects of Nazi ideology.

Karol Tendera won a court battle with the German ZDF television, which he sued for using the term "Polish death camp" in relation to Nazi-German camps in Majdanek and Auschwitz.

"Until the last moments of his life, he steadfastly fought for historical truth and won. A prisoner during the war, a hero of our times. RIP " - President Andrzej Duda on social media.
