

Exhibition "Phenomenon of Solidarity. Pictures from the History of Poland, 1980–1981" - Ottawa, Canada, 8-31 March 2012



From 8 to 31 March 2012 at the Morisset Hall at Ottawa University, an exhibition "Phenomenon of Solidarity. Pictures from the History of Poland, 1980–1981" is on display. The exhibition was created by the

Public Education Office of the Institute of National Remembrance in Poland in August of 2010, for the 30th anniversary of establishing of "Solidarity" Trade Union.

The presentation of the exhibition is possible thanks to cooperation between IPN, the Embassy of the Republic of Poland and the Department of History, Ottawa University.

A ceremonial opening of the exhibition took place on 8 March 2012 at the Morisset Hall (room MRT 251), 65 University Drive, Ottawa. It was accompanied by a lecture by Przemysław Gasztold-Seń from the Public Education Office of the Institute of National Remembrance dedicated to the history of the "Solidarity" Trade Union.

Visitors are cordially welcome.

The exhibition was prepared to commemorate 30th anniversary of the birth of the Solidarity Movement. It presents the important events from the strikes of August 1980 to the imposition of Martial Law in December 1981. The exhibit also depicts the path which led to the Solidarity Trade Union's establishment, its relations with the communist regime and the attitude of society towards the Trade Union within the context of the most important political, social and economic events of Poland.
