

International Holocaust Remembrance Day



International Holocaust Remembrance Day – 27 January, marks the liberation of the German concentration camp of Auschwitz-Birkenau.

The date was designated by the United Nations General Assembly in 2005 to honour the memory of the Jews murdered during the Second World War and is celebrated all over the world.

The IPN has been researching the history of the Holocaust and Polish-Jewish relations for many years. Its catalogue of scientific publications for the years 2000–2023 "Terror, Holocaust, Persecution. The Jewish Community under the Rule of the German and Soviet Totalitarianism in Polish Territories during 1939–1945 includes several dozen titles.
